

6 DAYS – AMAZING VALLEYS AND GREAT MOUNTAINS

A beautiful trip through ever changing scenery in both inhabited and abandoned valleys of the region „Dalir“ (= the Valleys) with unbelievable views and very good riding tracks to enjoy the Tölt! The ride starts at the old farmhouse Svarfhóll!

We have extra horses for the necessary equipment such as the picnic, rain gear, extra shoes for the horses etc.

To ensure a friendly atmosphere each group can't exceed 12 persons + guides.

We ride in small groups and offer personal and friendly service!

Dynhestar provides rain gear and helmets if needed. We recommend that the riders wear sturdy shoes and gloves.

The ride starts at the farm Bjargshóll.

All days are approx. ca 4-8 hours in saddle.

We have hot pot in every place we stay.



1. Day: Transfer – morning from Reykjavík/Keflavík to Svarfhóll – Dalir

It is ca (approx. 3.5 hours) trip to the Old farmhouse Svarfhóll in the West of Iceland. On the way we have a meal and then we get our rooms in Svarfhóll (4x). After that we have a ride to get acquainted with the horses (approx. 3-4 hours in the saddle)

2. Day: Svarfhóll – Dunkur /Svarfhóll

A great day on horseback with the herd awaits us: We will ride at the seashore, on the beach and across the mudflats. Excellent tölt tracks offer plenty of opportunities.

3. Day: Sea side – Álflheimar / Svarfhóll

Today we are riding again over the tideland and along the Hvammsfjörður.

4. Day: Álflheimar – Giljaland / Svarfhóll

Then we ride by the picturesque lake Haukadalsvatn

5. Day: Haukadalsskarð – Hrótafjörður

Over the beautiful mountain pass Haukadalsskarð we ride to the fjord Hrótafjörður at Staður. There are beautiful waterfalls and the elves are living here. Night-lodging at the Hostel Sæberg.

6. Day: Hrótafjörður – Bjargshóll

Last day. Riding home to the farm Bjargshóll over moraines to Miðfjörður with beautiful view at the river valley. The tour is ending in Bjargshóll.

Transfer to Reykjavík

After the ride - transfer to Reykjavík /Keflavík. On the way we will have dinner with the elves 😊
